Homeowner Affidavit

--- PLEASE READ COMPLETELY BEFORE SIGNING ---

Before the commencement of any new electrical wiring installation required by the Department of Labor and Industry to be inspected, the person responsible for making such installation shall submit to the department a Request for Electrical Inspection and the appropriate inspection fee.

Minnesota Statutes, section 326.01, subdivision 6e defines an "Owner" as "a natural person who physically performs electrical work on premises the person owns and <u>currently occupies as a residence</u> or <u>owns and will occupy as a residence upon completion of construction."</u>

An "owner" is exempt from electrical contracting license requirements and exemption only applies to electrical work performed by the owner on single family residence and associated structures. Both primary and secondary residences, such as lake homes are included, however the exemption does not apply to condominiums, rental properties or wiring not used for residential purposes. It is illegal for an owner to install electrical wiring on any property that is rented, leased or occupied by others.

I, the undersigned, certify that I own the residential property for which this application is being submitted. By signing this affidavit I certify that I qualify as defined by MN Statute §326.01, Subd. 6e to perform this work and <u>will personally and physically perform the work</u> indicated on the application form.

I further certify that <u>no other person will be contracted for or will be paid to perform this work</u>, including the layout of such work. I understand that any person other than myself performing electrical work on this residence is required to be a licensed, bonded and insured electrical contractor in the State of Minnesota and must submit a separate Request for Electrical Inspection for any work they perform.

I acknowledge that as the requesting homeowner I am personally responsible for any violation of the state electrical codes or other applicable laws or ordinances resulting from work performed on this property.
