



## **CAMPAIGN SIGN REGULATIONS**

*The City of South St. Paul administers a process to enforce State and City regulations related to the placement of signs in the right-of-way and on City property. The rules apply to political campaign signs for all candidates, regardless of whether they are seeking federal, state, county, city or school offices.*

*CITY CODE: All signs of any size containing noncommercial speech may be posted from 46 days before the state primary in any general election year until ten days following the general election and 13 weeks prior to any special election until 10 days following the special election.*

*Consistent with the laws of the State of Minnesota, campaign, private, and commercial signs are not allowed in the following locations:*

- *State, County and City property*
- *Public right-of-way for State or County highways*
- *Public right-of-way for State, County or City roads*
- *City property*

*If the City finds a violation on City property or right-of-way, the sign(s) will be removed and stored at City Hall located at 125 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue North. Please contact the Elections Department at 651-554-3266.*
